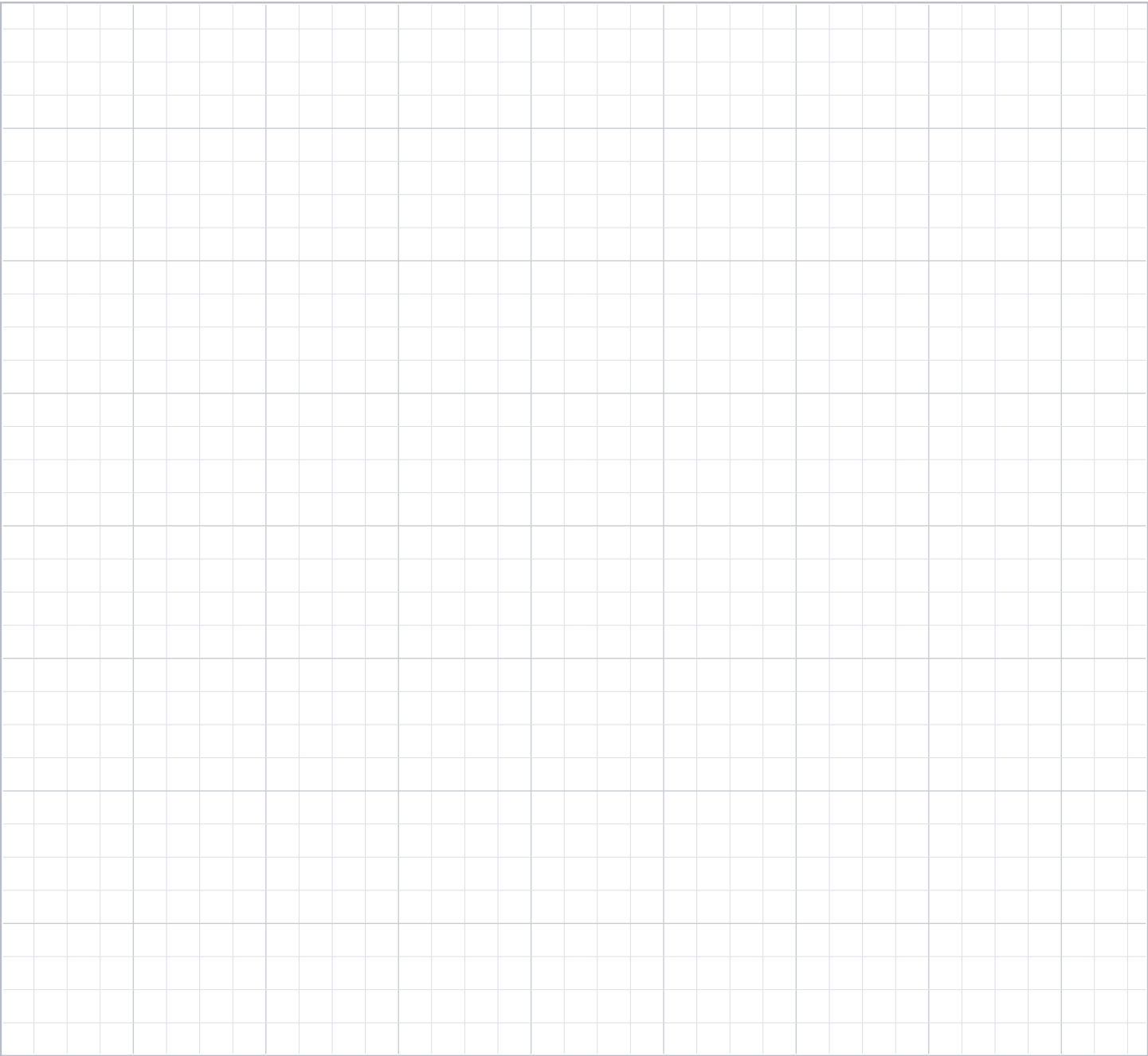


Room

Material size

Set a scale first — one square to six inches suits most rooms, one to a foot for a large floor. Draw the room, then lay out your first row and see where the cut lands at the far end. If it is about to finish on a sliver, shift the whole layout half a unit and you get a decent cut at both ends.



BEFORE YOU SET A SINGLE TILE

- ☐ Dry-lay the first full row with spacers, no adhesive
- ☐ Check where the cut lands at both ends and at the doorway
- ☐ Decide which line is the one people see from the door — start from that
- ☐ Mark your layout lines on the substrate, not on the tile
